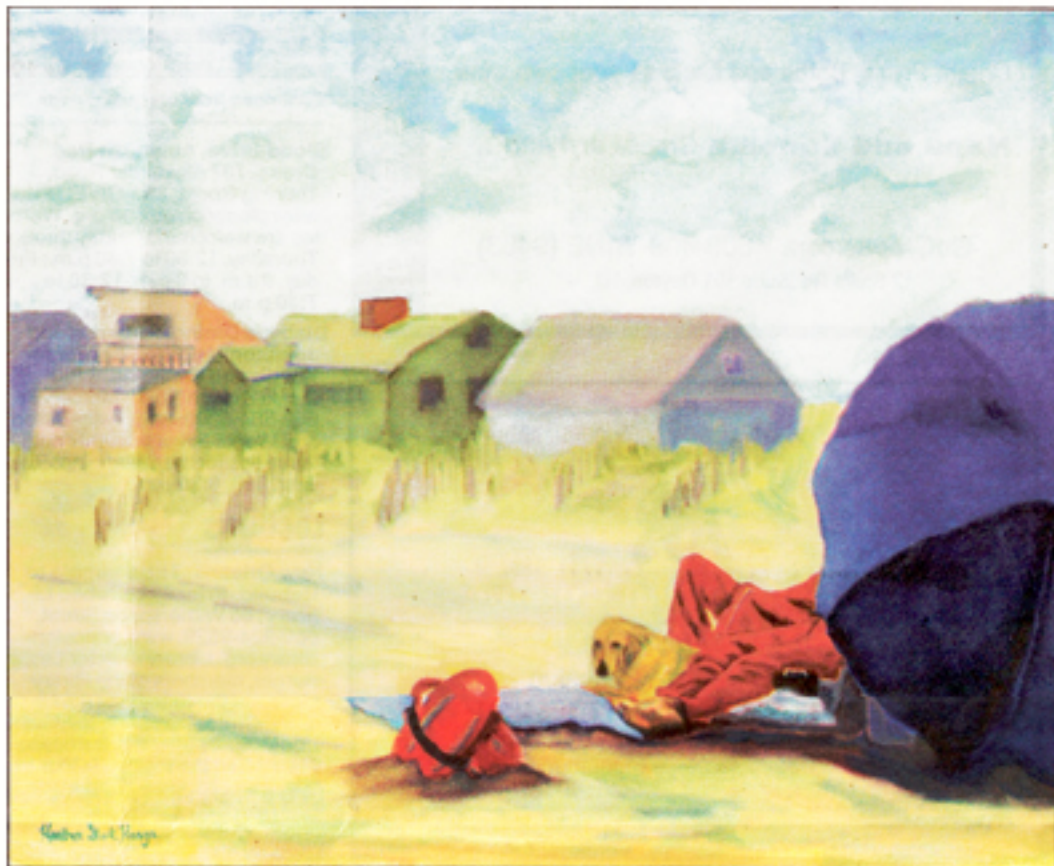
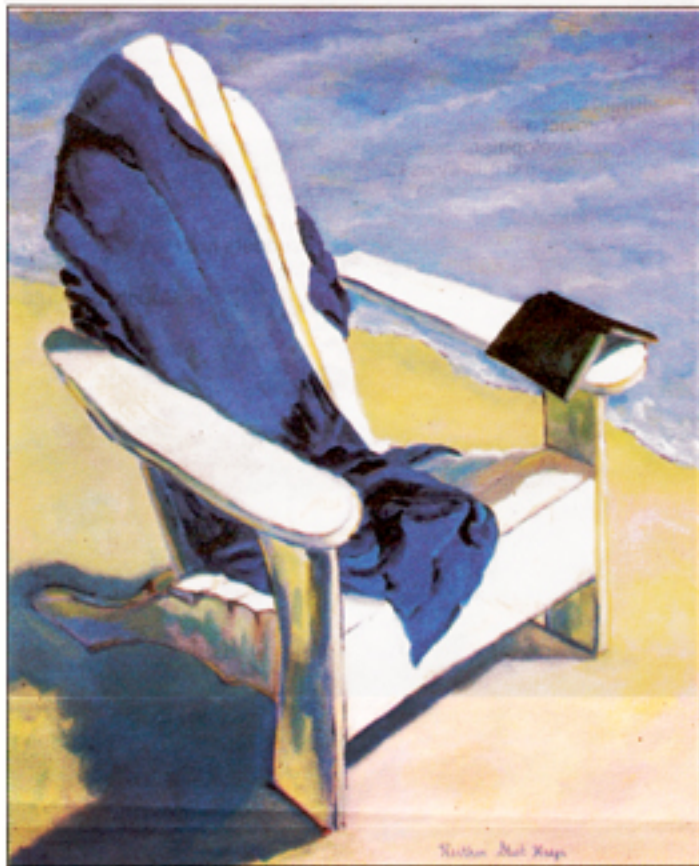

*A Painter's View: Swan Song to Summer*
